**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE-WIDE COMMUNICATIONS
EMERGENCY FREQUENCY FOR MUNICIPAL AND STATE
AGENCIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The sum of ____ dollars is
2 appropriated to the Department of Public Safety, from the General
3 fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for purposes of
4 providing the infrastructure necessary to establish a state-wide
5 communications emergency frequency accessible to both state and
6 local public safety agencies.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2002</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To have one emergency frequency used state-wide that would provide complete and competent communication between all state and local police, fire and emergency medical service departments.
