AN ACT EXPANDING THE DEDUCT-A-RIDE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Each individual, firm,
2 corporation, partnership, organization, the state or a political
3 subdivision of the state or any other entity that employs twenty-five or
4 more employees in one location shall offer to such employees the
5 benefits specified in Section 132(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of
6 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the
7 United States, as from time to time amended.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To require all employers that have twenty-five or more employees in one location to offer such employees the federal tax benefits of the Deduct-A-Ride program for mass transit, vanpooling and carpooling.
