AN ACT CONCERNING VOCATIONAL SERVICE PROGRAMS FOR PERSONS WITH HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS AND ACQUIRED IMMUNODEFICIENCY SYNDROME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The Department of Social
2 Services shall provide vocational and employment assistance
3 programs to persons with Human Immunodeficiency Virus and
4 Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome in Stamford and Hartford.
5 Such programs shall be located at community-based organizations
6 currently serving persons with Human Immunodeficiency Virus and
7 Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome. All such programs shall
8 include an evaluation component, to include outcome measures of the
9 number of clients served, number of persons who receive job training,
10 and the number of persons securing employment.

11 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The sum of five hundred thousand
12 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the
13 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, to provide
14 financial support for vocational and employment assistance programs
15 for persons with Human Immunodeficiency Virus and Acquired

16 Immunodeficiency Syndrome, in New Haven, Stamford and Hartford.

This act shall take effect as follows:
