AN ACT CONCERNING CONSOLIDATION OF FIRE DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the
2 provisions of sections 7-324 to 7-329, inclusive, of the general statutes
3 or any special act, municipal charter or home rule ordinance, any
4 municipality with two or more fire districts may consolidate such fire
5 districts, by ordinance adopted by its legislative body. Such ordinance
6 shall include provisions the legislative body deems necessary to
7 effectuate the consolidation, including, but not limited to, provisions
8 concerning the establishment of boundaries, distribution of assets and
9 liabilities, and specification of the membership, powers and duties of
10 the district.

This act shall take effect as follows:
