**AN ACT CONCERNING CONNECTICUT RESOURCE RECOVERY
AUTHORITY TIPPING FEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (9) of section 22a-265 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (9) Charge reasonable fees for the services it performs and waive,
5 suspend, reduce or otherwise modify such fees, provided (A) such
6 user fees shall apply uniformly within each municipality to all users
7 who are provided with waste management services with respect to a
8 given type or category of wastes, in accordance with criteria
9 established by the authority, [and provided further] (B) no change may
10 be made in user fees without at least sixty days prior notice to the
11 users affected thereby and an opportunity for a hearing, and (C) (i) no
12 increase in user fees approved by the authority between January 1,
13 2002, and twelve months after the effective date of this section shall
14 take effect until at least twelve months after the effective date of this
15 section, (ii) no such increase shall be effective unless a hearing on such
16 increase is held prior to its implementation, and (iii) any bonds or
17 notes issued under this chapter, together with the interest thereon, and
18 any operational costs of any facility operated or controlled by the
19 authority shall be paid during the twelve-month moratorium set forth
20 in subparagraph (C) (ii) of this subdivision by any funds under the

21 control of the authority that are not legally obligated for other
22 purposes.

This act shall take effect as follows:
