AN ACT DESIGNATING JUNE FOURTEENTH OF EACH YEAR AS HARRIET BEECHER STOWE DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is
2 amended by adding subdivision (47) as follows (*Effective June 1, 2002*):

3 (NEW) (47) The Governor shall proclaim June fourteenth of each
4 year to be Harriet Beecher Stowe Day, in honor of her birthday.
5 Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as
6 the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>June 1, 2002</i>

To honor Harriet Beecher Stowe on the anniversary of her birth.
