Substitute Bill No. 5659

February Session, 2002

AN ACT CONCERNING DOG LICENSE FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 22-338 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2002*):

4 (a) Each owner or keeper of a dog of the age of six months or older,
5 except dogs kept under a kennel license as provided in section 22-342,
6 shall cause such dog to be licensed in the town clerk's office in the
7 town where such dog is kept, on or before June thirtieth, annually, or
8 at such time as such dog becomes six months old, and annually
9 thereafter, on or before June thirtieth. The owner or keeper shall pay to
10 such town clerk for such license the sum of [~~five~~] seven dollars for each
11 neutered male or spayed female dog and the sum of nine dollars for
12 each unneutered male dog and each unspayed female dog, and one
13 additional dollar in each case as the town clerk's fee for issuing a tag
14 and license as provided in section 22-340. Two dollars from each
15 license fee collected for a neutered or spayed dog shall be deposited
16 into the Animal Population Control Fund. If an owner or keeper of a
17 dog fails to procure a license as required by this section, such owner or
18 keeper shall pay the appropriate license fee specified in this section,
19 the town clerk's fee and a penalty of one dollar for each month or
20 fraction thereof the dog remains unlicensed.

This act shall take effect as follows:
