**AN ACT EXTENDING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS
TO WELFARE-TO-WORK PARTICIPANTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 567 of the general statutes be amended to create a
- 2 federally subsidized program to extend unemployment compensation
- 3 benefits to newly employed welfare-to-work participants who were
- 4 subsequently unemployed during calendar years 2001 and 2002, and
- 5 would not otherwise qualify for unemployment compensation under
- 6 the regular base period, provided the participants were previously
- 7 employed for at least one-half of the regular base period.

Statement of Purpose:

To make unemployment compensation benefits available to certain unemployed welfare-to-work participants.
