AN ACT CONCERNING HOURS OF OPERATION FOR ART PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of section 19a-77 of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

4 (3) Recreation operations such as but not limited to creative art
5 studios for children that offer parent-child recreational programs and
6 classes in music, dance, drama and art that are no longer than two
7 hours in length during the school year and three hours in length
8 during any other time of the year, library programs, boys' and girls'
9 clubs, church-related activities, scouting, camping or community-
10 youth programs.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2002</i>
