AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE-WIDE 311 NUMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Public Utility
2 Control shall, in conjunction with the Department of Public Safety,
3 develop a plan for the implementation of a state-wide nonemergency
4 governmental telecommunications service to be known as 311 service.
5 Not later than January 1, 2004, the Department of Public Utility
6 Control shall submit such plan to the joint standing committee of the
7 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy and
8 technology in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
9 general statutes.

10 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) The sum of ____ dollars is
11 appropriated to the Department of Public Utility Control, from the
12 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the
13 development and implementation of a state-wide 311 nonemergency
14 service system pursuant to section 1 of this act.

This act shall take effect as follows:
