AN ACT CONCERNING RURAL DEVELOPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The sum of seventy-five thousand
2 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Economic and
3 Community Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
4 ending June 30, 2003, for a grant to the Connecticut Rural
5 Development Council for the provision of technical assistance and
6 training in economic development and land use principles to rural
7 municipalities.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2002</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funds to help smaller municipalities develop skills in economic and land use planning.
