**AN ACT CONCERNING REVOCATION OF A HEALTH PERMIT FOR
NONPAYMENT OF TAXES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 12-146a of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

3 Any municipality, as defined in subsection (a) of section 12-41, or
4 any district health department, formed under chapter 368f, may
5 withhold or revoke any license or permit, issued by such municipality
6 or district health department, to operate a business enterprise if any
7 taxes levied by such municipality or, in the case of a district
8 department of health, by any constituent municipality of such district,
9 against personal property used in such business enterprise are
10 delinquent and have been so delinquent for a period of not less than
11 [one year] ninety days.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2002</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen a municipal power to induce timely payment of property taxes.
