AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENTS OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND PUBLIC WORKS AND THE STATE PROPERTIES REVIEW BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The Commissioner of
2 Administrative Services shall review the functions and activities of the
3 department in order to assess the cost-effectiveness of such functions
4 and activities and assign priority for their continued funding. The
5 commissioner shall submit findings and recommendations to the joint
6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
7 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not
8 later than January 15, 2003, and annually thereafter.

9 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The Commissioner of Public
10 Works shall review the functions and activities of the department in
11 order to assess the cost-effectiveness of such functions and activities
12 and assign priority for their continued funding. The commissioner
13 shall submit findings and recommendations to the joint standing
14 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
15 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later

16 than January 15, 2003, and annually thereafter.

17 Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The chairperson of the State
18 Properties Review Board shall review the functions and activities of
19 the board in order to assess the cost-effectiveness of such functions and
20 activities and assign priority for their continued funding. The
21 chairperson shall submit findings and recommendations to the joint
22 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
23 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not
24 later than January 15, 2003, and annually thereafter.
