**"AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT ORDERS."**

1 In line 3, after "attend" insert "for up to a total of four full academic  
2 years"

3 In line 6, after the period, insert the following:

4 "An educational support order may be entered with respect to any  
5 child who has not attained twenty-three years of age and shall  
6 terminate not later than the date on which the child attains twenty-  
7 three years of age."

8 Strike lines 7 to 14, inclusive, and insert the following:

9 "(b) (1) On motion or petition of a parent, the court may enter an  
10 educational support order at the time of entry of a decree of  
11 dissolution, legal separation or annulment, and no educational support  
12 order may be entered thereafter unless the decree explicitly provides

13 that a motion or petition for an educational support order may be filed  
14 by either parent at a subsequent date. If no educational support order  
15 is entered at the time of entry of a decree of dissolution, legal  
16 separation or annulment, and the parents have a child who has not  
17 attained twenty-three years of age, the court shall inform the parents  
18 that no educational support order may be entered thereafter. The court  
19 may accept a parent's waiver of the right to file a motion or petition for  
20 an educational support order upon a finding that the parent fully  
21 understands the consequences of such waiver.

22 (2) On motion or petition of a parent, the court may enter an  
23 educational support order at the time of entry of an order for support  
24 pendente lite pursuant to section 46b-83 of the general statutes.

25 (3) On motion or petition of a parent, the court may enter an  
26 educational support order at the time of entering an order of support  
27 pursuant to section 46b-61 or 46b-171 or similar section of the general  
28 statutes, or at any time thereafter.

29 (4) On motion or petition of a parent, the court may enter an  
30 educational support order at the time of entering an order pursuant to  
31 any other provision of the general statutes authorizing the court to  
32 make an order of support for a child, subject to the provisions of  
33 sections 46b-212 to 46b-213v, inclusive, of the general statutes, as  
34 amended."

35 In line 54, after "as" strike "a" and insert in lieu thereof "is provided  
36 by law for any"

37 In line 54, insert a period after "order"

38 Strike line 55 in its entirety
