**"AN ACT CONCERNING OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE
UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR."**

1 After line 810, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 11. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2002*) (a) No person shall use
3 any instrument containing an alphanumeric keypad while operating a
4 motor vehicle on a public highway of this state or on any road of a
5 district organized under the provisions of chapter 105 of the general
6 statutes, a purpose of which is the construction and maintenance of
7 roads and sidewalks, or on any private road on which a speed limit
8 has been established in accordance with the provisions of section
9 14-218a of the general statutes, or in any parking area for ten or more
10 cars or on any school property.

11 (b) Violation of the provisions of subsection (a) of this section shall
12 be an infraction."
