**"AN ACT CONCERNING WATER UTILITY COORDINATING
COMMITTEES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 25-33g of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2002*):

6 (b) The committee shall establish preliminary exclusive service area
7 boundaries, based on the final assessment, for each public water
8 system within the management area, [. The] and may change such
9 boundaries. In establishing exclusive service area boundaries the
10 committee shall solicit comments on such boundaries from
11 municipalities, regional planning agencies, the Commissioners of
12 Environmental Protection and Public Health, the Department of Public
13 Utility Control, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management
14 and other interested persons within the management area and respond

15 to any comment received. If there is no agreement by the committee on
 16 such boundaries, or on a change to such boundaries, the committee
 17 shall consult with the Department of Public Utility Control. If there is
 18 no agreement by the committee after such consultation, the
 19 Commissioner of Public Health shall establish [exclusive service area
 20 boundaries] or may change such exclusive service area boundaries
 21 taking into consideration any water company rights established by
 22 statute, special act or administrative decisions. In establishing such
 23 boundaries the commissioner shall maintain existing service areas and
 24 consider the orderly and efficient development of public water
 25 supplies. In considering any change to exclusive service area
 26 boundaries, the commissioner shall maintain existing service areas,
 27 consider established exclusive service areas, and consider the orderly
 28 and efficient development of public water supplies.

29 Sec. 2. Subsection (c) of section 25-33h of the general statutes is
 30 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
 31 *October 1, 2002*):

32 (c) The Commissioner of Public Health shall adopt regulations in
 33 accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 establishing the contents
 34 of a plan and a procedure for approval or amendment to the plan."
