**"AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN TAXES RELATED TO HEALTH CARE."**

1 Strike section 5 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 5. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The sum of fourteen million dollars  
3 is appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General  
4 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002. Such funds shall be used  
5 to provide subsidized HUSKY Plan Part A program benefits for  
6 parents of children eligible for the HUSKY Plan Part A program whose  
7 household incomes are not greater than one hundred eighty-five per  
8 cent of the federal poverty level, provided the commissioner shall  
9 apply for and implement any federal waiver necessary to effectuate the  
10 purposes of this subsection.

11 (b) The sum of fourteen million dollars is appropriated to the  
12 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal  
13 year ending June 30, 2003. Such funds shall be used to provide  
14 subsidized HUSKY Plan Part A program benefits for parents of

15 children eligible for the HUSKY Plan Part A program whose  
16 household incomes are not greater than one hundred eighty-five per  
17 cent of the federal poverty level, provided the commissioner shall  
18 apply for and implement any federal waiver necessary to effectuate the  
19 purposes of this subsection. The unexpended balance of funds  
20 appropriated in subsection (a) of this section shall not lapse on June 30,  
21 2002, and such funds shall be available for expenditure during the  
22 fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the purposes of this subsection."
