**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TRACKING PROCEDURE FOR THE
REMAINS OF DECEASED PERSONS UNTIL INTERMENT."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Section 19a-405 of the general statutes is repealed and the
3 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2002*):

4 The Chief Medical Examiner, with the approval of the [commission]
5 Commission on Medicolegal Investigations, shall appoint a deputy
6 who shall perform all the duties of the Chief Medical Examiner in case
7 of his sickness or absence and such associate medical examiners,
8 assistant medical examiners, pathologists, toxicologists, laboratory
9 technicians and other professional staff as the commission may specify.
10 The commission shall set the salary for said deputy. The commission in
11 advance of appointments shall specify the qualifications required for
12 each position in terms of education, experience and other relevant
13 considerations and shall submit recommendations concerning salaries
14 and compensation of such professional staff to the Commissioner of

15 Administrative Services. The Chief Medical Examiner, the Deputy
16 Chief Medical Examiner, associate medical examiners, and assistant
17 medical examiners shall take the oath provided by law for public
18 officers. Other staff members as determined by the commission shall
19 be appointed by the Chief Medical Examiner, subject to the provisions
20 of chapter 67 and the rules of the commission not inconsistent
21 therewith."
