"AN ACT CONCERNING STATE MARSHALS."

1 After line 531, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 14. Subsection (b) of section 5-187c of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2002*):

6 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter: [, each]

7 (1) Each person employed as a judicial marshal pursuant to section
8 6-32d or 6-32f, as amended, on or after December 1, 2000, shall become
9 a member of the state employees retirement system on the date of such
10 employment and vesting and credited service shall be calculated from
11 the date of such employment, provided in no event shall an employee
12 receiving payments pursuant to section 5-164a or section 5-192v
13 receive vesting or credited service under this section.

14 (2) Each person employed as a judicial marshal pursuant to section

15 6-32d or 6-32f, as amended, on or after the effective date of this section
16 who served as a special deputy sheriff prior to becoming a judicial
17 marshal may elect to obtain credit under the state employees
18 retirement system for each year of such person's service as a special
19 deputy sheriff. Such election shall be made in writing to the
20 Retirement Commission. Persons so electing shall pay to the State
21 Employees Retirement Fund an amount for each year of such service
22 determined by the Retirement Commission as necessary to fund the
23 increased benefits payable by reason of such credit, provided (A) if
24 such person served as a special deputy sheriff for less than thirty-five
25 hours per week, such amount shall be prorated based on a forty hour
26 workweek, and (B) such amount may be paid in installments over a
27 period not to exceed three years. The provisions of this subdivision
28 shall be in addition to any applicable requirements contained in a
29 collective bargaining agreement covering such person."
