2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "in early childhood education, child development, elementary

5 sociology, or a related field that includes at least twelve credits in
6 courses related to early childhood education or child development, or
7 be enrolled in a continuing education program that leads toward a
8 baccalaureate degree in early childhood education, child development,
9 elementary education, human development and family relations,
10 psychology, sociology, or a related field that includes at least twelve
11 credits in courses related to early childhood education or child
12 development, and shall have not less than a total of six years
13 combination higher education and work experience at a program
14 development and supervisory level in a program that provides
15 services to children, or a Child Development Associate (CDA) or

16 associate's degree in early childhood education, child development,
17 elementary education, human services, psychology, sociology, or a
18 related field that includes at least twelve credits in courses related to
19 early childhood education or child development, with not less than
20 four years of experience working at a program development and
21 supervisory level in a program that provides services to children.
22 These qualifications shall only apply to staff hired on and after October
23 1, 2002."

26 "(e) All persons employed by the Department of Public Health to
27 conduct family day care home inspections as provided in subsection
28 (b) of this section shall have attained, as a prerequisite to conducting
29 such inspections, a baccalaureate degree in early childhood education,
30 child development, elementary education, human development and
31 family relations, psychology, sociology, or a related field that includes
32 at least twelve credits in courses related to early childhood education
33 or child development, or enrolled in a continuing education program
34 that leads toward a baccalaureate degree in early childhood education,
35 child development, elementary education, human development and
36 family relations, psychology, sociology, or a related field that includes
37 at least twelve credits in courses related to early childhood education
38 or child development, and shall have not less than a total of six years
39 combination higher education and work experience at a program
40 development and supervisory level in a program that provides
41 services to children, or a Child Development Associate (CDA) or
42 associate's degree in early childhood education, child development,
