**"AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE DURING PERIODS OF EMERGENCY OR DISASTER."**

1 Strike subsection (b) in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "(b) Any licensed, certified or registered practitioner described in  
4 subsection (a) of this section who renders emergency medical or  
5 professional assistance, pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, at the  
6 scene of an emergency to a person in need thereof, shall not be liable to  
7 such person assisted for civil damages for any personal injuries which  
8 result from acts or omissions by such practitioner that may constitute  
9 ordinary negligence. The immunity provided in this subsection does  
10 not apply to acts or omissions constituting gross, wilful or wanton  
11 negligence."
