"AN ACT CONCERNING WATER SUPPLY PLANS."

1 Strike lines 97 to 101, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(NEW) (d) The Commissioner of Public Health shall adopt
4 regulations, in accordance with chapter 54, to clarify the criteria under
5 which a well permit exception may be granted or denied, clarify when
6 an existing water supply well may be used, and describe the terms and
7 conditions that shall be imposed when a well is allowed at a premise
8 that is connected to a public water supply system. Such regulations
9 shall (1) provide for notification of the permit to the public water
10 supplier, (2) address the quality of the water supplied from the well,
11 the means and extent to which the well shall not be interconnected
12 with the public water supply, the need for the physical separation and
13 the installation of a reduced pressure device for backflow prevention,
14 the inspection and testing requirements of any such reduced pressure
15 device, and (3) consider the relative costs to install public water service

16 as compared to a private well at the premises."
