"AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL PAROLE."

1 After section 2, add the following:

2 "Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of
3 Correction shall not enter into any contract or renewal of a contract
4 with any governmental or private vendor for the supervision of
5 inmates outside the state pursuant to subsection (a) of section 18-86b of
6 the general statutes, as amended by this act, on or after the effective
7 date of this section, unless the commissioner submits such proposed
8 contract to the General Assembly or to the joint standing committee on
9 the judiciary, as provided in this section, and such contract is approved
10 in accordance with the provisions of this section.

11 (b) During periods when the General Assembly is in session, the
12 commissioner shall submit such proposed contract to the General
13 Assembly and such proposed contract shall be referred to the joint
14 standing committee on the judiciary which shall report thereon within

15 ten days of the date of its submittal. The General Assembly may reject
16 such proposed contract by a three-fifths vote of each house. Such
17 provision shall be deemed approved if the General Assembly fails to
18 approve or reject such proposed contract within thirty days of the date
19 of its submittal.

20 (c) During periods when the General Assembly is not in session, the
21 commissioner shall submit such proposed contract to the joint
22 standing committee on the judiciary. Within thirty days, the judiciary
23 committee may, upon the call of either chairperson, hold a special
24 meeting for the purpose of approving or rejecting such proposed
25 contract. The committee may reject such proposed contract by a three-
26 fifths vote of the total membership of the committee. Such proposed
27 contract shall be deemed approved if the judiciary committee fails to
28 approve or reject such proposed contract within thirty days of its
29 submittal."
