**"AN ACT CONCERNING WELL DRILLERS, PHARMACISTS,
ELECTRONIC SHELF-PRICE LABELING, HEALTH CLUBS, THE
LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, BUILDING PERMITS FOR
TRADEPERSONS, HOME IMPROVEMENT BONDS, LEMON LAW
FUNDING AND SHORTHAND REPORTERS."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 10. Subsection (b) of section 30-86 of the general statutes, as
3 amended by section 1 of public act 01-92, is repealed and the following
4 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

5 (b) Any permittee or any servant or agent of a permittee who sells
6 or delivers alcoholic liquor to any minor, or to any intoxicated person,
7 or to any habitual drunkard, knowing the person to be such an
8 habitual drunkard, shall be subject to the penalties of section 30-113.
9 Any person who sells, ships, delivers or gives any such liquors to such
10 minor, by any means, including, but not limited to, the Internet or any
11 other on-line computer network, except on the order of a practicing
12 physician, shall be fined not more than one thousand five hundred

13 dollars or imprisoned not more than eighteen months, or both. The
14 provisions of this section shall not apply (1) to a sale, shipment or
15 delivery made to a person over age eighteen who is an employee or
16 permit holder under section 30-90a and where such sale, shipment or
17 delivery is made in the course of such person's employment or
18 business, (2) to a sale, shipment or delivery made in good faith to a
19 minor (A) who practices any deceit in the procurement of [an] any of
20 the following: (i) An identity card issued in accordance with the
21 provisions of section 1-1h, as amended, (ii) a government-issued
22 identification card approved by the Department of Consumer
23 Protection, (iii) a passport, or (iv) a driver's license issued by any state
24 of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of
25 Puerto Rico or any territory or insular possession subject to the
26 jurisdiction of the United States, (B) who uses or exhibits any such
27 identity [card] or identification card, passport or driver's license
28 belonging to any other person, or (C) who uses or exhibits any such
29 identity [card] or identification card, passport or driver's license that
30 has been altered or tampered with in any way, or (3) to a shipment or
31 delivery made to a minor by a parent, guardian or spouse of the minor,
32 provided such parent, guardian or spouse has attained the age of
33 twenty-one and provided such minor possesses such alcoholic liquor
34 while accompanied by such parent, guardian or spouse. For the
35 purposes of this subsection, a sale, shipment or delivery made in good
36 faith means that the permittee or agent of the permittee acted in
37 reasonable reliance upon the identification presented."
