**"AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE DURING PERIODS OF EMERGENCY OR DISASTER."**

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- 1       Strike lines 14 to 21, inclusive, in their entirety
- 2       In line 22, strike "(c)" and insert "(b)" in lieu thereof
- 3       After the last section, insert the following:
- 4       "Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2002*) (a) Notwithstanding section
- 5       19a-14 of the general statutes, as amended, or any other provisions of
- 6       the general statutes relating to continuing education or refresher
- 7       training, the Department of Public Health shall renew a license,
- 8       certificate, permit or registration issued to an individual pursuant to
- 9       chapters 368d, 368v, 370 to 388, inclusive, 393a, 395, 398, 399, 400a and
- 10      400c of the general statutes, which becomes void pursuant to section
- 11      19a-88 of the general statutes, as amended, or section 2 of public act 01-
- 12      1 while the holder thereof is on active duty in the armed forces of the
- 13      United States, within six months from the date of discharge from
- 14      active duty, upon payment of any applicable renewal fee and upon

15 completion of any continuing education or refresher training required  
16 to renew a license, certificate, registration or permit which has not  
17 become void pursuant to section 19a-88 of the general statutes, as  
18 amended, or section 2 of public act 01-1. A licensee applying for license  
19 renewal pursuant to this section shall submit an application on a form  
20 prescribed by the department and other such documentation as may  
21 be required by the department.

22 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to reservists or  
23 National Guard members on active duty for annual training that is a  
24 regularly scheduled obligation for reservists or members of the  
25 National Guard for training which is not a part of mobilization.

26 (c) No license shall be issued under this section to any applicant  
27 against whom professional disciplinary action is pending or who is the  
28 subject of an unresolved complaint."
