**"AN ACT CONCERNING A TRANSFER UPON DEATH OPTION IN  
THE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM."**

1 Strike subdivision (15) of subsection (b) of section 6 in its entirety  
2 and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(15) [if married,] is assured privacy for visits by the patient's spouse  
4 or a person designated by the patient in accordance with section 3 of  
5 this act and if both are inpatients in the facility, they are permitted to  
6 share a room, unless medically contraindicated, as documented by the  
7 attending physician in the medical record, or unless the nursing home  
8 facility is affiliated with a religious organization and declines to permit  
9 such visits or room-sharing;"
