1 After line 10, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) On or before September 1,  
3 2002, the Secretary of the State shall compile a state-wide list of  
4 persons serving as justices of the peace, indexed by last name. The list  
5 shall include, for each person, the municipality which made the  
6 nomination as well as the term of office of such person. The Secretary  
7 of the State shall publish such list on the Secretary's web site on the  
8 Internet and shall provide a printed copy of such list to any person  
9 upon request."
