**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF INSURANCE  
DEPARTMENT RECORDS."**

1 After the last section, add the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 1 of substitute house bill 5641 of the  
3 current session is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
4 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

5 (a) Each insurer that issues, renews, amends or endorses an  
6 individual Medicare supplement policy or certificate, or an  
7 automobile, [or] homeowners or individual long-term care insurance  
8 policy in this state on or after October 1, 2002, shall include with the  
9 policy a conspicuous statement specifying that any individual aged  
10 fifty-five or over may designate a third party to receive notice of  
11 cancellation or nonrenewal of the policy. The statement shall include a  
12 designation form and mailing address the senior citizen may use to  
13 designate a third party. Such statement shall be in a form approved by

14 the Insurance Commissioner. As used in this section, "individual long-  
15 term care insurance policy" means a long-term care policy, as defined  
16 in section 38a-501, or an individual long-term care policy that is  
17 precertified pursuant to section 38a-475."
