**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF INSURANCE
DEPARTMENT RECORDS."**

1 After the last section, add the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 1 of substitute house bill 5641 of the
3 current session is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
4 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

5 (a) Each insurer that issues, renews, amends or endorses an
6 individual Medicare supplement policy or certificate, or an automobile
7 or homeowners insurance policy in this state on or after October 1,
8 2002, shall include with the policy a conspicuous statement specifying
9 that any individual aged fifty-five or over may designate a third party
10 to receive notice of cancellation or nonrenewal of the policy. The
11 statement shall include a designation form and mailing address the
12 senior citizen may use to designate a third party. Such statement shall
13 be in a form approved by the Insurance Commissioner."
