1 After line 196, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 8. Subsection (g) of section 10-266aa of the general statutes, as
4 amended by section 29 of public act 01-1 of the June special session, is
5 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
6 *1, 2002*):

7 (g) The Department of Education shall provide, within available
8 appropriations, an annual grant to the local or regional board of
9 education for each receiving district in an amount not to exceed two
10 thousand dollars for each out-of-district student who attends school in
11 the receiving district under the program. Each town which receives
12 funds pursuant to this subsection shall make such funds available to its
13 local or regional board of education in supplement to any other local
14 appropriation, other state or federal grant or other revenue to which

15 the local or regional board of education is entitled. In addition to such
16 funding, the sending district shall send one hundred per cent of its per
17 pupil funding pursuant to section 10-262h, as amended, prior to any
18 reduction pursuant subsection (h) of this section, to the receiving
19 district."
