"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF MILITARY DISCHARGE DOCUMENTS."

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Subdivision (53) of section 12-81 of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
4 *October 1, 2002, and applicable to assessment years commencing on or after*
5 *October 1, 2002*):

6 (53) (a) One passenger motor vehicle belonging to, leased to, or held
7 in trust for, any member of the United States armed forces, if such
8 motor vehicle is garaged outside the state;

9 (b) Any person claiming the exemption provided under this
10 subdivision for any assessment year shall, not later than the thirty-first
11 day of December next following the date on which property tax is due
12 in such assessment year, file with the assessor or board of assessors, in
13 the town in which such motor vehicle is registered, written application
14 claiming such exemption on a form approved for such purpose by

15 such assessor or board. Failure to file such application as prescribed
16 herein with respect to any assessment year shall constitute a waiver of
17 the right to such exemption for such assessment year."
