**"AN ACT CONCERNING EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND
TEACHERS' RETIREMENT."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 13. Subdivision (7) of section 10-183b of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
4 *1, 2002*):

5 (7) "Contributions" mean amounts withheld pursuant to this chapter
6 and paid to the board by an employer from compensation payable to a
7 member. "Mandatory contributions" are contributions required to be
8 withheld under this chapter and consist of "six per cent and thirty-five-
9 hundredths contributions" and "one per cent contributions".
10 "Voluntary contributions" are contributions by a member authorized to
11 be withheld under section 10-183i.

12 Sec. 14. Subsection (a) of section 10-183n of the general statutes is
13 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*

14 1, 2002):

15 (a) Each employer shall: (1) Before employing a teacher notify such
16 teacher of the provisions of this chapter applicable to such teacher; (2)
17 distribute, post or otherwise disseminate in a timely manner, to
18 teachers in its employ, any notices, bulletins, newsletters, annual
19 statements of account and other information supplied by the board for
20 the purpose of properly notifying teachers of their rights and
21 obligations under the system; (3) furnish to the board at times
22 designated by said board such reports and information as the board
23 deems necessary or desirable for the proper administration of the
24 system; and (4) deduct each month seven and thirty-five-hundredths
25 per cent of one-tenth of such teacher's annual salary rate as directed by
26 said board and any additional voluntary deductions as authorized by
27 such teacher, except that no deductions shall be made from any
28 amounts received by regularly employed teachers for special teaching
29 assignments rendered for the State Board of Education or the Board of
30 Governors of Higher Education unless the salary for such special
31 teaching assignment is equal to or greater than the minimum salary
32 paid for such teacher's regular teaching assignment."
