**"AN ACT CONCERNING EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND  
TEACHERS' RETIREMENT."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 13. Subsection (c) of section 10-66ee of the general statutes, as  
3 amended by section 27 of public act 01-1 of the June special session, is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
5 *1, 2002*):

6 (c) (1) The state shall, annually, pay in accordance with this  
7 subsection, to the fiscal authority for a state charter school, [seven]  
8 eight thousand dollars for each student enrolled in such school. Such  
9 payments shall be made as follows: Twenty-five per cent of the  
10 amount not later than July fifteenth and September fifteenth based on  
11 estimated student enrollment on May first, and twenty-five per cent of  
12 the amount not later than January fifteenth and the remaining amount  
13 not later than April fifteenth, each based on student enrollment on  
14 October first. (2) In the case of a student identified as requiring special

15 education, the school district in which the student resides shall: (A)  
16 Hold the planning and placement team meeting for such student and  
17 shall invite representatives from the charter school to participate in  
18 such meeting; and (B) pay the state charter school, on a quarterly basis,  
19 an amount equal to the difference between the reasonable cost of  
20 educating such student and the sum of the amount received by the  
21 state charter school for such student pursuant to subdivision (1) of this  
22 subsection and amounts received from other state, federal, local or  
23 private sources calculated on a per pupil basis. Such school district  
24 shall be eligible for reimbursement pursuant to section 10-76g, as  
25 amended. The charter school a student requiring special education  
26 attends shall be responsible for ensuring that such student receives the  
27 services mandated by the student's individualized education program  
28 whether such services are provided by the charter school or by the  
29 school district in which the student resides."
