1 After line 9, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Subsections (a) and (b) of section 12-81f of the general
3 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
4 (*Effective July 1, 2002*):

5 (a) Any municipality, upon approval by its legislative body, may
6 provide that any veteran entitled to an exemption from property tax in
7 accordance with subdivision (19) of section 12-81 shall be entitled to an
8 additional exemption applicable to the assessed value of property up
9 to the amount of [one] ten thousand dollars. [, provided such veteran's

10 qualifying income does not exceed the applicable maximum amount as
11 provided under section 12-811.]

12 (b) Any municipality, upon approval by its legislative body, may
13 provide that any veteran's surviving spouse entitled to an exemption
14 from property tax in accordance with subdivision (22) of section 12-81
15 shall be entitled to an additional exemption applicable to the assessed
16 value of property up to the amount of [one] ten thousand dollars. [,
17 provided such surviving spouse's qualifying income does not exceed
18 the maximum amount applicable to an unmarried person as provided
19 under section 12-811.]"
