**"AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL NUTRITION."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 3. (NEW) (a) Any municipality that enacts an ordinance  
3 providing for the regulation of smoking in public places in a manner  
4 that is more restrictive than the provisions of section 19a-342 of the  
5 general statutes shall post a sign along each access road into the  
6 municipality, at or near the border of such municipality, stating the  
7 nature of the public smoking restrictions imposed in such municipality  
8 and including the citation of such ordinance.

9 (b) Each restaurant in any municipality that enacts an ordinance  
10 providing for the regulation of smoking in public places in a manner  
11 that is more restrictive than the provisions of section 19a-342 of the  
12 general statutes shall post a sign stating the nature of the smoking  
13 restrictions imposed in or near such restaurant and including the  
14 citation of such ordinance.

15 (c) The state shall pay the cost of all signs required under this  
16 section."
