**"AN ACT CONCERNING PREVENTING DEATHS FROM DRUG  
OVERDOSE."**

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 4. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2002*) (a) Any municipality that  
3 enacts an ordinance providing for the regulation of smoking in public  
4 places in a manner that is more restrictive than the provisions of  
5 section 19a-342 of the general statutes shall post a sign along each  
6 access road into the municipality, at or near the border of such  
7 municipality, stating the nature of the public smoking restrictions  
8 imposed in such municipality and including the citation of such  
9 ordinance.

10 (b) Each restaurant in any municipality that enacts an ordinance  
11 providing for the regulation of smoking in public places in a manner  
12 that is more restrictive than the provisions of section 19a-342 of the  
13 general statutes shall post a sign stating the nature of the smoking

14 restrictions imposed in or near such restaurant and including the  
15 citation of such ordinance.

16 (c) The state shall pay the cost of all signs required under this  
17 section."
