"AN ACT CONCERNING METHODS OF MITIGATING THE EFFECTS OF REVALUATION IN A MUNICIPALITY SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SPECIAL ACT 01-1."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding any
4 provision of the general statutes or special act 01-1, for the period
5 commencing May 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2006, each municipality
6 subject to the provisions of special act 01-1, that provides health
7 insurance coverage to a retiree of the municipality as of the effective
8 date of this section, shall continue to provide health insurance
9 coverage to such retiree that is at least equivalent to the health
10 insurance coverage provided, as of the effective date of this section, to
11 the majority of unclassified employees of such municipality who (1)
12 are not members of an employee organization, as defined in

13 subdivision (6) of section 7-467 of the general statutes, or an
 14 organization described in subsection (b) of section 10-153a of the
 15 general statutes, and (2) are not in positions funded by grants, unless
 16 such reduced health insurance coverage is (A) not inconsistent with
 17 the terms of collective bargaining agreement or contract applicable to
 18 such retiree, (B) agreed to by such retiree or the legal representative of
 19 such retiree, or (C) made pursuant to the provisions of section 10-183t
 20 of the general statutes.

21 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of special act 01-1, for the period
 22 commencing May 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2006, no municipality
 23 subject to the provisions of special act 01-1 shall change the health
 24 insurance coverage of a retiree of such municipality who, on the
 25 effective date of this section, is covered by Medicare Part B and such
 26 municipality's fully insured Medicare supplement insurance policy or
 27 certificate."

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>
