"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BROOKFIELD WATER COMPANY."

1 After the last section, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 6. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No person shall engage in
3 hunting or trapping on watershed lands owned by The Brookfield
4 Water Company without the permission of said company.

5 Sec. 7. Section 26-73 of the general statutes is repealed and the
6 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

7 (a) Sunday shall be a closed season except for the purpose of
8 trapping under the provisions of this chapter. The possession in the
9 open air on Sunday of any implement for hunting shall be prima facie
10 evidence of hunting in violation of the provisions of this section. No
11 provision of this section shall be construed so as to affect any provision
12 of section 26-31, 26-48, 26-52 or 27-35 or apply to the use of bow and

13 arrow for purposes other than hunting. Artificially propagated birds
14 designated by the commissioner may be shot on Sundays on licensed
15 private shooting preserves subject to such regulations of the
16 commissioner as may apply to such private shooting preserves,
17 provided permission so to shoot has been obtained from the town or
18 towns within which such licensed private shooting preserves are
19 located.

20 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section,
21 hunting on Sunday with a bow and arrow is permissible providing
22 such hunting is (1) on private property, (2) during the regular hunting
23 season, (3) conducted after obtaining the written permission of the
24 property owner, and (4) conducted while carrying such written
25 permission."
