## ***AN ACT CONCERNING STATE JOB CLASSIFICATIONS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Commissioner of  
2 Administrative Services shall establish a job classification series for  
3 marital and family therapists licensed under chapter 383a of the  
4 general statutes and professional counselors licensed under chapter  
5 383c of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows:
