Substitute House Bill No. 6429

House of Representatives, April 29, 2003

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. LAWLOR of the 99th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING DISABILITY RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) There is established a task force to
2 address issues concerning the Americans with Disabilities Act and the
3 disability laws of this state. The task force shall be convened by the
4 Office of Protection and Advocacy for Persons with Disabilities and
5 shall be composed of advocates for the disabled and representatives of
6 the business community. The task force shall report its findings and
7 recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General
8 Assembly on the judiciary in accordance with section 11-4a of the
9 general statutes not later than February 1, 2004.

This act shall take effect as follows:
