Substitute House Bill No. 6642

*House of Representatives, April 22, 2003*

The Committee on Public Health reported through REP. FELTMAN of the 6th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING EXPANSION OF EXISTING STRUCTURES ON WATER COMPANY LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of  
2 chapter 474 of the general statutes, or the regulations of Connecticut  
3 state agencies, the city of Groton may change the use of its water  
4 company-owned class II lands to allow the Pequot Medical Center to  
5 expand its existing facilities on such lands currently leased or to be  
6 leased from the city of Groton by the Pequot Medical Center, and to  
7 allow for storm water drainage facilities on water company-owned  
8 land outside of such leased area to provide for such expansion.

This act shall take effect as follows:
