Substitute Senate Bill No. 646

*Senate, April 10, 2003*

The Committee on Government Administration and Elections reported through SEN. DEFRONZO of the 6th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN OFFICIAL STATE-WIDE STUDENT VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Secretary of the State  
2 shall annually designate, after consultation with registrars of voters, a  
3 period of time between January first and May thirty-first for a state-  
4 wide student voter registration drive and shall coordinate and  
5 publicize such drive.

This act shall take effect as follows:

**Explanation**

This bill requires the Secretary of the State to designate, in consultation with registrars of voters, a Statewide Student Voter Registration Drive period of time between January 1 and May 31.

The Secretary of State will incur a minimal workload increase to coordinate and publicize the student voter registration drive, which will not require additional funding.

This bill requires the secretary of the state to designate a period of time each year between January 1 and May 31 for a Statewide Student Voter Registration Drive. She must make the designation in consultation with the state's registrars of voters and she must coordinate and publicize it.
