The Committee on Judiciary reported through SEN. MCDONALD of the 27th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF ADMINISTRATORS BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 18-82 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

3 The Commissioner of Correction shall appoint and may remove the
4 following administrators, all of whom shall serve at the pleasure of the
5 commissioner and shall be exempt from the classified service: All
6 wardens of correctional institutions, all state community center
7 wardens [] and all detention center wardens. [, all correctional service
8 directors and all regional support services administrators.] Such
9 individuals shall possess skill and experience in correctional
10 administration.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	October 1, 2003

***AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF
ADMINISTRATORS BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION***

SUMMARY:

This bill eliminates the Department of Correction commissioner's duty to appoint and authority to remove all correction service directors, and all regional support services administrators as unclassified employees. These administrative positions no longer exist.
