***AN ACT CONCERNING INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY CALLS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) A person is guilty of  
2 interfering with an emergency call when such person verbally or  
3 physically obstructs, prevents or hinders another person from making  
4 or completing a 9-1-1 telephone call or a telephone call or radio  
5 communication to any law enforcement agency to request police  
6 protection or report the commission of a crime.

7 (b) Interfering with an emergency call is a class A misdemeanor.
