AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF THE INTERSTATE IDENTIFICATION INDEX SYSTEM FOR CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Department of
2 Public Safety shall access the Interstate Identification Index System on
3 behalf of any person, firm or corporation that employs persons to
4 coach minors participating in athletics when such person, firm or
5 corporation performs preemployment criminal background checks on
6 such persons.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2003</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To allow private employers of athletic coaches of minors to use the Interstate Identification Index System when performing preemployment criminal background checks.
