**AN ACT MAKING THE COMMISSION ON AGING PART OF THE
LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 17b-420 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2003*):

4 (c) There shall be an executive director of the Commission on Aging
5 who shall be appointed by the commission. There may be additional
6 staff within available appropriations. The commission shall be [within
7 the Department of Social Services for administrative purposes only]
8 part of the Legislative Department.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	July 1, 2003

To amend the general statutes to provide that the Commission on
Aging shall be part of the Legislative Department.
