AN ACT RESCINDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO SEEK A WAIVER FROM FEDERAL LAW CONCERNING TRANSFER OF ASSETS UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4 of public act 01-2 of the June special session shall be
- 2 repealed and the Commissioner of Social Services shall immediately
- 3 withdraw any waiver application submitted pursuant to said section.
- 4 The provisions of any waiver application submitted by the
- 5 commissioner pursuant to section 4 of public act 01-2 of the June
- 6 special session, approved by the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare
- 7 Services prior to the effective date of this act, shall not be implemented.

Statement of Purpose:

To rescind the Commissioner of Social Services' authority to seek a waiver from federal law concerning transfer of assets under the Medicaid program.
