**AN ACT CONCERNING FREE PRIVATE LAND DEER PERMITS FOR CERTAIN FARMERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 26-29c of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

3 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 26-27, the Commissioner  
4 of Environmental Protection shall issue, without fee, a private land  
5 deer permit for use only on a farm provided: (1) The farm is an S  
6 corporation or a limited liability corporation; and (2) the permit is  
7 issued to a corporate member or the immediate family of the corporate  
8 member, or to a partner or immediate family of the partner of the  
9 limited liability corporation. No such corporate member, partner or  
10 family member shall be issued more than one such permit per season.  
11 The permit shall allow the use of a rifle, shotgun, muzzleloader or bow  
12 and arrow on the farm from November first until December thirty-  
13 first, inclusive, of each year. For purposes of this section, "S  
14 corporation" means "S corporation", as defined in section 12-213,  
15 "limited liability corporation" means a company that is treated as a  
16 limited liability company for federal income tax purposes and

17 "immediate family" means a spouse, child, grandchild, sibling or  
18 parent.

This act shall take effect as follows:
