**AN ACT CONCERNING A PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR
CERTAIN FARM BUILDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-91 of the general statutes be amended to allow any
- 2 municipality, upon approval by its legislative body, to exempt from
- 3 the property tax any farm building with an assessed value of up to one
- 4 hundred thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen the state's agricultural economy and encourage farmland preservation while protecting the state's rural atmosphere.
