***AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCEDURE FOR HOLDING A REFERENDUM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-369 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any person aggrieved by the results of a state or municipal
- 3 referendum may bring a complaint to a judge of the Superior Court
- 4 within fourteen days after such referendum, and that such complaint
- 5 shall be handled by the judge in the same manner as a complaint
- 6 brought pursuant to section 9-324 or 9-328 of the general statutes.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To allow a person aggrieved by the results of a referendum to bring a complaint in the Superior Court within fourteen days.
